## <u>Visit of the Delegation from the Supreme People's Court of Vietnam – 5 September 2025</u>



Our Chairman, Keith Brandt welcomed to ICC- Hong Kong, on Friday evening, 5th September a delegation of jurists from Vietnam, led by Ms. Nguyễn Hà Nhật Anh, and accompanied by 6 others from various departments of from the Supreme People's Court of Vietnam. The delegates had previously visited on their trip to Hong Kong and met officials from the Hong Kong High Court, visited the Court of Final Appeal in Central and met officials from the Hong Kong International arbitration Centre. The Chairman, together with another Dispute Resolution Partner, Richard Keady from ICC- Hong Kong Corporate Member, Dentons Hong Kong, led a lively discussion responding to multiple questions about the options for the establishment of the new specialist Court, including such important matters, as the choice of judges, the language to be adopted by the Court, and options for choice of procedural rules.

At the conclusion of the meeting, ICC- Hong Kong's Chairman was presented and accepted on behalf of our National Committee, a splendid picture of the Supreme Court of Vietnam.
